*Dates beginning with the Classic Alaskan Tour followed by the Wildland Glacier experience 2 nights between trips (Sat. night and Sun night). We include one night accommodation in Anchorage in the trip cost and can arrange the other night in Anchorage on request. Please note: This trip order is 14 days in length total including one unguided day in Anchorage between trips.

**Dates beginning with the Wildland Glacier Tour include 1 night accommodations between trips (Sat.). Please note: This trip order is 13 days in length total.

What's Included: A full time Alaska Outdoors guide, hotel accommodations in Seward, Anchorage, and Wrangell St Elias National Park, top of the line camping equipment, all but 2 meals per trip (taken at restaurants), transportation throughout, park entrance fees and specified included activities.

- 4 night's hotel or cabins
- Walk on Alaska's largest accessible glacier
- Explore the impressive turn of the century ghost town of Kennicott
- ½ day scenic ferry trip across Prince William Sound past the impressive Columbia Glacier
